Civic Center Fountain Repairs Civic Center Park, Saint Joseph, MO

Restoration Waterproofing Contractors Project Manager Shawn Smoke worked with Dave Simpson with the City of Saint Joseph to find a way to bring this historic fountain in Civic Center Park back to life, while preserving its historic appearance and function.

At the beginning of the project the top urn was missing. The project managers were able to use a single historic photo to replicate the missing elements.

The Civic Center Fountain had not functioned in its original configuration since the early 1990s. The city was able to fill the fountain and use an improvised method to run and spray the water, but the fountain was not able to run the original way it was designed.

RWC started work on the fountain in May of 2014 and finished repairs in July. Clyde Chapman was the Foreman for RWC.

The fountain restoration work made the news on KQ2 NEWS Saint Joseph, which filmed a story that ran over the summer.
